25 26 27 28 29 30 31	The purpose of this amendment is to encourage cooperation between state agencies in the conduct of the ground water study and to make the annual reporting requirements realistic. An additional \$5,000 is added to the appropriation to support study of soil movement mechanisms and synergistic effects of agricultural pesticides.
