Amend the bill in section 2, in the first para-
graph, in the first line (page 2, line 1 in L.D.) by
inserting after the underlined word "Survey" the un-
derlined words 'in cooperation with other agencies as
appropriate'

Further amend the bill in section 2, in the 2nd
paragraph in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines
11 and 12 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined
words "findings and recommendations" and inserting in

STATEMENT OF FACT

25

The purpose of this amendment is to encourage co-
operation between state agencies in the conduct of
the ground water study and to make the annual report-
ing requirements realistic. An additional \$5,000 is
added to the appropriation to support study of soil
movement mechanisms and synergistic effects of agri-
cultural pesticides.
