'4. Adoption of budget. After completion of the 3 public hearing, the county commissioners may further 4 increase, decrease, alter and revise the proposed 5 itemized budget, provided that: 6 The county commissioners shall enter into their minutes a statement of the basis for any 7 8 rejection of any recommendation of the budget adq visory committee; and 10 B. The total estimated revenues, together with 11 the amount of county tax to be levied, shall 12 equal the total estimated expenditures. 13 The proposed itemized budget shall be finally adopted by a majority vote of the county commissioners at a 14 duly called meeting not later than the end of the 15 county's fiscal year. The approved budget shall be 16 17 the final authorization for the assessment of county 18 taxes. HOUSE AMENDMENT "heta" COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 300, L.D. 389

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to create a Kennebec County Budget Advisory Commitee. The members of this committee will be appointed by the county commissioners, rather than going through a costly election process. The amendment places the committee in an advisory position only. Under this amendment, the county commissioners are given the authority to finally adopt the budget for Kennebec County.
