STATEMENT OF FACT

2 Current laws provide that licenses and certifi-3 cates expire on December 31st of each license year. 4 This has created a problem and inconvenience for many 5 of state shellfish dealers and processors. Many of 6 them are not in operation during this recertification 7 period as their businesses are seasonal.

8 Changing the certification date to April 30th 9 makes the recertification process coincidental to the 10 time when most of the dealers and processors are op-11 erating and eliminates many of the inconveniences to 12 dealers and processors that are currently being expe-13 rienced.

14 Current laws pertaining to municipal shellfish 15 conservation programs give authority to municipalities for implementing those programs within municipal 16 jurisdictions. Implementation of those programs nor-17 18 mally require local adoption of ordinances. Those ordinances must be approved by the Commissioner of Marine Resources. This bill authorizes the commis-19 20 Marine Resources. 21 sioner to adopt regulations which set the basis for 22 approval of municipal ordinances providing municipalities with clearer guidelines on what should be con-23 24 sidered in local management programs.
