6	state programs or other 3rd party providers.
7	STATEMENT OF FACT
8	This bill provides a state subsidy for preschool
9	special education programs operated by public
10	schools. It allows federal and state grants to be
11	used as seed money for evented state subsidy under
12	the School Finance Act. The commissioner has control
13	over the number and quality of the programs through
14	the requirement that services eligible for state sub-
15	sidy must be approved by the commissioner. It also
16	provides an incentive for school administrative units
17	to collect payments for certain special services,
18	presently the responsibility of other 3rd party pay-
19	ors.
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
