18	in its place the following:
19	'1. Educational institution. "Educational in-
20	stitution" means any public elementary or secondary
21	school; any elementary or secondary private school
22	approved for tuition whose school enrollment is at
23 24	least 60% publicly-funded students as determined by the previous school year's October to April average
25	enrollment; any nonpublic post-secondary school; or
26	any vocational region.
27	STATEMENT OF FACT
28	The purpose of this amendment is to authorize
29	private secular schools to purchase state surplus
30	property. This amendment limits this privilege to
31 32	private secular schools approved by the State for tu- ition. Currently public schools are authorized to
33	purchase state surplus property.
