Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Leo lature do not become effective until 90 days as adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and	
Whereas, the Legislature wishes to reduce length of its sessions and establish fixed caler dates for adjournment; and	
Whereas, it is vitally necessary to put this stitutional reform into effect at the earliest pos ble time to conserve tax dollars; and	in- ssi-

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:
