AN ACT to Repeal the Tax Exemption for Income  
Received as Winnings from the Maine Lottery.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

8 MRSA §367, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 570, §1,  
is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provision which exempted prizes received pursuant to the State Lottery from the state income tax.
