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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 164, L.D. 433,
Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Municipal Public Employees
Labor Relations Act to Provide for Newly Recognized
or Certified Bargaining Agent to Bargain Fiscal Mat-
ters within 120 Days of Conclusion of Current Fiscal
Operating Budget."

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Amend the bill in subsection 1, the last para-
graph, the 10th line (page 2, line 33 in L.D.) by in-
serting after the underlined word "agent" the follow-
ing "of a newly formed bargaining unit"

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to make certain
that only bargaining agents of newly formed bargain-
ing units are exempt from the 120-day notice require-
ment of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section
965, subsection 1. The bill, as clarified by this
amendment, is not intended to affect existing bar-
gaining units that may change their bargaining agent
after the notice is required but before the current
county or municipal fiscal operating budget ends; the
120-day notice requirement still applies to those
bargaining agents.
