11 12 13	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
14 15 16 17 18	Whereas, there is a need to look at the operation of the Department of Personnel to discern the needs of the department and the means by which the department's functions can be performed in the most expeditious manner; and
19 20 21 22	Whereas, the Department of Personnel has embarked upon an evaluation of some but not all of its functions in order to determine department needs and to develop solutions to some of its problems; and
23 24 25	Whereas, it is essential for the Department of Personnel to include additional factors in its study; and
26 27 28	Whereas, it is essential that the Legislature receive the results of this study in sufficient time to evaluate any proposed implementing legislation; and
29 30 31 32 33 34	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'

10	STATEMENT OF FACT
11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21	The purpose of this amendment is to enable the Department of Personnel to immediately include in its study an analysis of its operations with respect to hiring delays, computerization and application procedures. In addition, the Department of Personnel will report its findings to the Joint Standing Committee on State Government by October 1, 1985, which will give the committee time to evaluate the study and its results as well as recommendations for legislation to be submitted to the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature.
