21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 39 MRSA §22-D is enacted to read:

24 §22-D. Manual rates for certain security guards and  
25 watchmen

26 After the effective date of this section, whenever  
27 contracts for unarmed security guard services or  
28 unarmed watchmen services are issued or renewed, the  
29 workers' compensation manual rate per \$100 of payroll  
30 shall be 1/2 of the manual rate per \$100 of payroll  
31 for armed public law enforcement officers.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require that the workers' compensation manual rate for unarmed security guards and watchmen be set at 1/2 the manual rate for armed public law enforcement officers.

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
