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18 AN ACT to Make Allocations from the Maine  
19 Coastal Protection Fund for the Fiscal  
20 Years Ending June 30, 1986, and June  
21 30, 1987.

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23 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
24 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
25 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

26 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-  
27 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

28 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-  
29 dent to the operation of the department will become  
30 due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1985;  
31 and

32 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
33 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
34 the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
35 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

1 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
2 therefore,

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
4 follows:

5       **Sec. 1. Allocation of Maine Coastal Protection**  
6 **Fund.** Income to the Maine Coastal Protection Fund  
7 for the next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1985, to  
8 June 30, 1986, and from July 1, 1986, to June 30,  
9 1987, shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed  
10 as designated in the following schedule:

21       **Sec. 2. Research and Development.** In accordance  
22 with Public Law 1969, chapter 572, not more than  
23 \$100,000 per annum of the total amounts allocated in  
24 section 1 of this Act shall be devoted to research  
25 and development in the causes, effects and removal of  
26 pollution caused by oil, petroleum products and their  
27 by-products on the marine environment.

28       **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited  
29 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July  
30 1, 1985.
