STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to more closely implement the directives of Governor Percival P. Baxter as set forth in the THIRD clause of his inter vivos trust dated July 6, 1927, as amended May 18, 1966, and further to recognize that the Baxter State Park Authority, as trustee for the Baxter State Park and as such responsible for administering the principal object of this part of the trust, is the most appropriate state agency to receive additional funds for the purchase of other lands as specified in the trust.
