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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 341, L.D. 458,
"Resolve, Creating the Commission to Study Emergency
Medical Services in Maine."

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Amend the resolve by striking out all of the 2nd
paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 23 to 32 in
L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

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'Appointment. Resolved: That the commission
shall consist of 21 members, as follows: Two members
of the House of Representatives to be appointed by
the Speaker of the House; one member of the Senate to
be appointed by the President of the Senate; the Com-
missioner of Human Services or his designee; 2 repre-
sentatives from each of the 6 regional emergency med-
ical services' councils, of which one member from
each council shall be a volunteer ambulance member;
one member from the State Fire Chiefs Association;
one member from the Professional Ambulance Associa-
tion; one Emergency Room physician; one Emergency
Room registered nurse; and one hospital administra-
tor. The members shall be appointed in a timely man-
ner and the commission shall hold an organizational
meeting at the call of the chairman of the Legisla-
tive Council within 30 days after the effective date
of this Act. At this meeting, the commission shall
select a chairman from among its members; and be it
further'

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Further amend the resolve by striking out all of
the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs before the statement of
fact (page 2, lines 9 to 16 in L.D.) and inserting in
their place the following:

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'Reports. Resolved: That the commission shall
present its findings, together with any recommended
legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the

3 Expenses. Resolved: That the members of the
4 commission who are not state employees shall receive
5 expenses for meals and travel in accordance with the
6 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 377; and be
7 it further

8 Appropriation. Resolved: That the amount of
9 \$5,000 is appropriated from the General Fund to carry
10 out the purposes of this resolve; and be it further'

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This amendment adds additional members to the
13 commission, changes the reporting date, clarifies the
14 expenses allowed and adds an appropriation of \$5,000
15 to the resolve.
