17 Resolve, Creating the Commission to Study
18 Emergency Medical Services in Maine.
19

20 Commission established. Resolved: That there is
21 established the Commission on Emergency Medical Ser-
22 vices; and be it further

23 Appointment. Resolved: That the commission
24 shall consist of 10 members, as follows: Two members
25 of the House of Representatives to be appointed by
26 the Speaker of the House; one member of the Senate to
27 be appointed by the President of the Senate; the Com-
28 missioner of Human Services or his designee; one rep-
29 resentative from each of the 6 regional emergency
30 medical services' councils. The commission shall
31 select a chairman from among its members; and be it
32 further

33 Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall
34 study:

35 1. The state, local and regional relationships
36 of emergency medical services' providers;

1 2. The funding of emergency medical services in
2 the State;

3 3. The current functions and future feasibility
4 of regional councils;

5 4. The future direction of emergency medical
6 services in the State; and

7 5. Current laws and regulations dealing with
8 emergency medical services; and be it further

9 **Reports. Resolved:** That the commission shall
10 present its findings, together with any recommended
11 legislation, to the First Regular Session of the
12 113th Legislature; and be it further

13 **Expenses. Resolved:** That the members of the
14 commission shall not receive any compensation, but
15 shall be reimbursed for their necessary expenses; and
16 be it further

17 **Acceptance and expenditure of funds. Resolved:**
18 That the commission may accept funds from any agency
19 of the United States or from any other public or pri-
20 vate source, and may use these funds and any other
21 funds appropriated to the commission to hire person-
22 nel, contract services or for other purposes neces-
23 sary to carry out this resolve.

24 STATEMENT OF FACT

25 The purpose of this resolve is to establish the
26 Commission on Emergency Medical Services.

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
