20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

24 25 26 27 28 29	A. Any agency may settle any claim for an amount of $\$500$ $\$2,000$ or less when such settlement is approved by the appropriate department or agency head in accordance with regulations promulgated by the Commissioner of Finance and Administra- tion.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, state agencies may settle tort claims 2 3 under \$500. Claims that exceed \$500 must be for-4 warded to the Commissioner of Finance and Administration and the Attorney General before they can be set-5 tled by a state agency. This bill allows state agen-6 7 cies to settle tort claims under \$2,000 rather than the present ceiling of \$500. The bill allows small 8 9 claims of \$2,000 or less to be more expeditiously resolved. 10

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
