26 27	Whereas, the town would like to begin the renovations as soon as possible; and

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 175, L.D. 467

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to enable the Town of Wells to begin negotiations with the Commis-6 7 sioner of Finance and Administration as soon as pos-8 sible for the town's acquisition of the former state police building in Wells. The town will be required 9 to undertake significant renovations which will re-10 11 quire considerable time. The building is presently vacated in a state of disrepair. The Town of Wells 12 could use the facility for its law enforcement de-13 14 partment.
