COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 175, L.D. 467,  
"Resolve, Authorizing the Conveyance of a Certain Un-  
used Building and Land Owned by the State to the Town  
of Wells."

Amend the resolve by inserting after the title  
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves  
of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;  
and

Whereas, the Town of Wells would like to negoti-  
ate with the Commissioner of Finance and Administra-  
tion, as soon as possible, with respect to the acqui-  
sition of the former state police building in Wells;  
and

Whereas, a number of major renovations and reha-  
bilitation are required prior to occupation of the  
building which will delay the town's occupation of  
the building; and

Whereas, the town would like to begin the  
renovations as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
therefore, be it'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end  
before the Statement of Fact the following:

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 175, L.D. 467

1 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited  
2 in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when  
3 approved.'

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this amendment is to enable the  
6 Town of Wells to begin negotiations with the Commis-  
7 sioner of Finance and Administration as soon as possi-  
8 ble for the town's acquisition of the former state  
9 police building in Wells. The town will be required  
10 to undertake significant renovations which will re-  
11 quire considerable time. The building is presently  
12 vacated in a state of disrepair. The Town of Wells  
13 could use the facility for its law enforcement de-  
14 partment.
