17 AN ACT Relating to Registration
18 of Electrologist.
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1221, as enacted by PL 1979, c.
23 87, §1, is amended to read:

24 §1221. Definitions

25 As used in this chapter, unless the context oth-
26 erwise indicates, the following terms ~~shall~~ have the
27 following meanings.

28 1. Department. "Department" ~~shall mean~~ means the
29 Department of Human Services.

30 1-A. Electrologist. "Electrologist" means a
31 person who practices electrology.

1 2. Electrology. "Electrology" ~~shall mean~~ means
2 the practice of removing hair permanently by applying
3 electricity to the hair follicle to cause inserting a
4 filament, needle or probe down the hair follicle wall
5 and applying an electric current to the dermal
6 papilla causing growth inactivity, permanently, to
7 the hair root.

8 2-A. Electrolysis. "Electrolysis" means the
9 process by which electrology is done.

10 3. Person. "Person" ~~shall mean~~ means any indi-
11 vidual, firm, partnership, corporation or other asso-
12 ciation or organization.

13 Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1231, as enacted by PL 1979, c.
14 87, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its
15 place:

16 §1231. Procedure

17 Except as provided in section 1233, the depart-
18 ment shall register any person under this chapter
19 who:

20 1. Education. Provides the department with a
21 notarized copy of a certificate of completion from a
22 school accredited to provide instruction in
23 electrology indicating that the applicant has suc-
24 cessfully completed a minimum of 600 hours of train-
25 ing at an accredited school; and

26 2. Inspection. Passes an inspection under sec-
27 tion 1243 within 60 days before that person is regis-
28 tered.

29 Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §1231-A is enacted to read:

30 §1231-A. Reciprocity

31 Except as provided in section 1233 and notwith-
32 standing the requirements of section 1231, the de-
33 partment shall register any applicant under this
34 chapter who provides the department with evidence
35 that the applicant has 2 years of experience as an
36 electrologist. That proof must consist of notarized
37 copies of the license or registration issued by the

1 State or states where the applicant last practiced
2 electrology.

STATEMENT OF FACT

4 The purpose of this bill is to establish an edu-
5 cation requirement for registration as an
6 electrologist.
