Sec. 3. 4 MRSA §157, sub-§1, ¶A, as repealed and replaced by PL 1983, c. 863, Pt. B, §§7, 45, is amended to read:

A. The Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary and to confirmation by the Legislature, shall appoint to the District Court 7 4 judges at large and 15 16 judges. At least one judge shall be appointed in each district who shall be a resident of the district, except that in District 3 there shall be 2 judges appointed who shall be residents of the district and in District 9 there shall be 2 judges appointed who shall be residents of the district. Each District Court Judge shall have a term of office of 7 years.

To be eligible for appointment as a District Judge, a person shall be a member of the bar of the State. The term "District Judge" shall include the Chief Judge, Deputy Chief Judge, the judges appointed from the districts and the judges at large.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to create a new District Court district comprised of Sagadahoc County and Eastern Cumberland County.
