15 16 17	Whereas, the Maine Sentencing Guidelines Commission established by the 111th Legislature completed much of the study assigned to it; and
18 19	Whereas, a few of the tasks of studying sentencing guidelines remain to be completed; and
20 21 22	Whereas, the members of the Maine Sentencing Guidelines Commission and other interested persons are eager to continue with the study; and
23 24	Whereas, the Legislature will benefit from the expeditious completion of the study; and
25 26 27 28 29 30	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

9 10 11	Further amend the bill in section 8 by striking out all of the last 3 lines (page 5, lines 10 to 12 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:
12	'Personal Services \$11,200
13	All Other3,800
14	Total \$15,000'
15 16	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
17 18 19	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
20	STATEMENT OF FACT
21 22 23 24	The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency and require appointment of commission members within 30 days of the Act's effective date so that the commission may continue its work immediately.
