10 lines before the Statement of Fact (page 1, lines 34
11 and 35 in L.D.) the following: "clergyman and all
12 persons exempt under Title 37-A, section 1117" and
13 inserting in their place the following: 'clergy,
14 Christian Science practitioners and readers and all
15 persons exempt under Title 37-A, section 1117 Title
16 37-B, section 185'

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 The purpose of this amendment is to exempt clergy
19 and Christian Science practitioners and readers from
20 jury duty. The amendment also corrects a reference
21 to a recodified statute.
