18 on Which Statewide General Election is

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 28 MRSA §4, 4th ¶, as repealed and re-  
24 placed by PL 1975, c. 741, §2, is repealed as fol-  
25 lows:

26 ~~Liquor may be sold in any municipality on the day~~  
27 ~~of holding a general election or state-wide primary~~  
28 ~~after the polls of that municipality have closed.~~

29 Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §4, 6th ¶, as amended by PL  
30 1975, c. 770, §131, is further amended to read:

31 The hours of selling or delivering referred to  
32 shall be the legal time prevailing in the State on  
33 the day of the sale. ~~Except that wholesalers of malt~~  
34 ~~beverages and table wine may make deliveries to li-~~

1 eensees on the day of holding a general election or  
2 state-wide primary.

4 The purpose of this bill is to permit the sale of  
5 liquor on state election days.
