2 The office of the clerk shall be open a minimum of 4 hours on the Saturday immediately preceding a 3 4 general election to allow voters to obtain or cast 5 absentee ballots. In order to be valid, an absentee ballot must be delivered to the municipal clerk be-6 7 fore 8 p.m. on election day, except in the presiden-8 tial election absentee ballots may be delivered to the elerk at any time before the elosing of the 9 10 pells.

STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill provides for uniform polling times at 13 all voting places in the State. All polls will open 14 at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m.
