HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 366, L.D. 486,
Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Sheriffs' Deputies to Hold
Nonpartisan Local Elected Office."

Amend the bill by striking out the title and in-
serting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Allow Sheriffs' Deputies to Hold
Nonpartisan Local Office.'

Further amend the bill after the amending clause,
in the first paragraph, in the first line (page 1,
line 24 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "hold"
the following: 'the municipal office of selectman,
city councilman or budget committeeman or' and in the
first paragraph, first line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.)
by striking out the word "other" and inserting in its
place the following: '~~other~~'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates the word elected in the
title thereby bringing the title in line with the
text of the bill. The amendment also prohibits depu-
ty sheriffs from holding certain municipal offices.
