17 AN ACT to Allow Sheriffs' Deputies to Hold
18 Nonpartisan Local Elected Office.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 30 MRSA §951, last ¶, as repealed and replaced by
23 PL 1981, c. 394, §4, is amended to read:

24 A full-time deputy shall not hold any other mu-
25 nicipal, county or state office, and may reside out-
26 side the county during the term of his appointment
27 only with the permission of the sheriff and county
28 commissioners.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to allow all sheriffs' deputies to additionally hold a municipal office if appointed or elected.

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
