STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require an environmental impact study before any aquaculture lease is granted. This bill would keep the negative impact of aquaculture operations on both the environment and competing fisheries to a minimum. It will also provide base-line information for the long-term study of the impact of aquaculture on both the environment and traditional fisheries.
