Donald E. Davey was killed in the line of duty on July 30, 1984, while he was enroute to an investigation for the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department. Detective Sergeant Davey was an 11-year veteran of the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department. He was born in Rockland, Maine. He is survived by his wife, the former Laurinda Lash and 2 daughters, Jessica and Cecily.
