signs a certificate or bounty slip under oath stating 1 2 that he killed that animal and the time and place 3 within the State. The certificate shall be approved 4 by and bear the signature of the warden or warden su-5 pervisor in whose district the animal was killed, 6 stating that he believes the animal to have been killed at the time and place stated in the certifi-7 8 cate. The person claiming the bounty shall forward to 9 the commissioner the claimant's certificate or bounty slip in a form as prescribed by the commissioner. 10

11 Upon receipt by the State Controller of a certif-12 icate from the commissioner, the controller shall au-13 dit the claim for bounty and the same shall be paid forthwith by the Treasurer of State to the claimant 14 15 from fines and penalties recovered and money received 16 or collected under any provision of the fisheries and 17 wildlife laws or amendments thereof, or for sale of 18 any seized or confiscated articles.
