AN ACT to Require the State to Comply with Municipal Ordinances Governing the Construction of Buildings.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
5 MRSA §1742-B is enacted to read:
§1742-B. Municipal building ordinances
State construction projects and public improvements to state-owned or leased buildings shall comply with municipal ordinances governing the construction and alteration of buildings. The Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements shall obtain all necessary municipal building permits and state-owned or leased buildings shall be subject to municipal inspections.

The purpose of this bill is to require the State to obtain necessary municipal building permits for state construction projects and public improvements to state-owned or leased buildings. Presently, the State is not required to comply with local ordinances governing the construction of buildings.

Because most state buildings receive their fire and police protection from municipalities, it is most important that local public safety officials are familiar with the construction and internal layout of state buildings. This bill ascertains that local public safety officials will have access to state building layout information in the event police or fire assistance is needed.

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
