22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 P&SL 1961, c. 176, §3-A is enacted to read:

25 Sec. 3-A. Personal property tax delinquency.
26 Any municipality with an ordinance enacted under the
27 authority of this chapter may refuse to issue or re-
28 new a license when the applicant is delinquent in
29 paying any personal property tax assessed by the mu-
30 nicipality.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill permits the municipalities authorized under Private and Special Law 1961, chapter 176, to refuse to issue or renew a license for businesses which are subject to a licensing ordinance if the business is delinquent in paying personal property taxes. This bill allocates this authority to the Private and Special Law 1961, chapter 176, which establishes the licensing ordinance for those towns.

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
