17 AN ACT to Make the Photo Drivers License
18 Discretionary.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §540, as amended by PL 1983, c. 455, §18,
23 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

24 §540. Contents of license

25 Each license shall state the name, mailing ad-
26 dress, municipality of legal residence, date of
27 birth, date of license expiration, sex, height and
28 weight of licensee. The license may at the request
29 of the licensee include the color of hair, color of
30 eyes, blood type, religious preference or a photo-
31 graph of the licensee.

32 A fee of \$2 shall be charged for the photographic
33 license in addition to the license fee. All requests
34 for photographic licenses shall be submitted through

1 the clerk of the municipality of legal residence,
2 with a 2 by 3 inch photograph. The municipal clerk
3 shall certify to the Secretary of State that the pho-
4 tograph is a reasonable likeness of the applicant,
5 shall retain \$1 of the fee for the photographic li-
6 cence and shall forward the application with photo-
7 graphic securely attached to the Secretary of State.

8 Every licensee shall endorse his usual signature
9 in the place designated before using his license.
10 The place designated shall provide adequate space for
11 the signature.

12 The Secretary of State shall provide with each
13 license issued an anatomical gift form which may be
14 completed and carried by the licensee.

15 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 The purpose of this bill is to make photo drivers
17 licenses discretionary.

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
