18 Reimbursement to Boarding Care

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 22 MRSA §7907, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 708, §1,  
24 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

25 §7907. Boarding care payments

26 The department shall reimburse those boarding  
27 care facilities subject to reimbursement at a flat  
28 rate not to exceed \$650 per resident per month and  
29 those boarding care facilities subject to reasonable  
30 cost reimbursement at a rate not to exceed \$650 per  
31 resident per month.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill revises the payment system followed by the Department of Human Services for compensating operators of boarding care facilities by increasing the amount of compensation to be paid by the department.

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
