17 AN ACT to Increase the Daily Compensation of
18 Substitute Teachers.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 20-A MRSA §13402, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1983,
23 c. 520, is further amended to read:

24 3. Substitute teachers. Substitute teachers
25 shall be compensated at the rate of not less than \$30
26 \$50 for each day of service. Substitute teachers em-
27 ployed by a school administrative unit for more than
28 2 days in a school year shall meet the requirements
29 of section 13003.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the minimum daily compensation of substitute teachers and to require that after teaching in a school administrative unit for more than 2 days that substitute teachers must be certified.

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
