-	The Supreme Judicial Court shall be located in the city of Augusta.

The commission shall consist of 9 members to be appointed as follows: Two members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, 2 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, 2 members appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court and 2 members appointed by the Governor.

1 2 3 4 5	Sec. 3. Duties of commission. The commission shall investigate any possible consolidation of existing functions and personnel of the Supreme Judicial Court and the disposition and aquisition of court facilities.
6 7 8 9	Sec. 4. Report. The commission shall report its findings together with any implementing legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature.
10 11 12	Sec. 5. Compensation. The members of the commission shall receive no compensation, but shall be reimbursed for all necessary expenses.
13 14 15	Sec. 6. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
