of Maine at a statewide election to be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November fol-3 lowing passage of this Act. The city aldermen, town 4 selectmen and plantation assessors of this State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the manner 6 prescribed by law for holding a statewide election, 8 to vote on the acceptance or rejection of this Act by voting on the following question:

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"Shall county government be abolished and its functions and duties reassigned to appropriate state municipal departments and agencies?"

legal voters of each city, town plantation shall vote by ballot on this question, and shall designate their choice by a cross or check mark placed within a corresponding square below "Yes" or "No." The ballots shall be received, sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town plantation meetings and returns made to the Secretary in the same manner as votes for members of of State the Legislature. The Governor shall review the turns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal are in favor of the Act, the Governor shall votes proclaim that fact without delay, and section 2 this Act shall become effective 30 days after the date of the proclamation. Section 1 of this shall take effect January 1, 1987.

Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation all ballots, turns and copies of this Act necessary to carry out the purposes of this referendum.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for a referendum vote to abolish county government. If the bill is approved, the Legislature will enact legislation reassigning existing county functions, duties and powers to appropriate state and municipal departments and agencies.

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
