## STATEMENT OF FACT

4 Currently in Maine, insurance carriers are able 5 to write liability policies for motorcycles which ex-6 clude liability coverage to "guest passengers." 7 Since passengers are the ones most likely to be in-8 jured in a collision, and since motorcycle accident 9 injuries are often very serious, there exists a 10 strong public policy consideration against allowing 11 such an exclusion.

12 This bill ensures that all motor vehicle liabili-13 ty insurance policies issued with respect to motorcy-14 cles in this State indemnify the insured motorcycle 15 operator up to the limits of coverage for damages to 16 at least one, and possibly more, passenger or passen-17 gers depending on whether a motorcycle is equipped to 18 carry more than one passenger.

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
