17 AN ACT to Regulate the Drilling of Wells.  
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
20 follows:

21 22 MRSA §2610 is enacted to read:

22 §2610. Drilled water supply wells; minimum distance

23 After the effective date of this section, no per-  
24 son may drill a water supply well within 150 feet of  
25 any existing water supply well owned by a person oth-  
26 er than the person for whom the well is being  
27 drilled.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           This bill lessens the possibility of the drilling  
3 of one well effecting the water level in adjacent  
4 wells. It requires a minimum distance of 150 feet  
5 between all drilled wells.
