17 AN ACT Relating to Fishing by Net, Trap or
18 Weir in the Waters of Union River Bay in
19 Hancock County.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 12 MRSA §6955 is enacted to read:

24 §6955. Fishing in waters of Union River Bay

25 It is unlawful to fish with any type of net, trap
26 or weir from April 15th to August 1st in any year in
27 the waters of Union River Bay, Hancock County, inland
28 from a straight line extended from an imaginary line
29 extended from Newbury Neck Surry to the end of Oak
30 Point in Trenton. This section does not prohibit
31 fishing for smelt by the use of hand held dip nets or
32 the taking alewives as granted by section 6131, sub-
33 section 5.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to prohibit fishing
3 by means of net, trap or weir in the waters of Union
4 River Bay in Hancock County.

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
