17 18 19	AN ACT Concerning Remuneration for Substitute School Teachers.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13402, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1983, c. 520, is further amended to read:
24 25 26 27 28 29 30	3. <u>Substitute teachers</u> . Substitute teachers shall be compensated at the rate of not less than \$30 for each day of service except that substitute teach- ers with teacher certification shall be compensated at the rate of, but not less than, 1/180 of the units minimum starting annual salary for teachers for each day of service.
31 32 33 34	After each 180 days of teaching, a substitute teacher shall receive an increase in pay, per day, as pre- scribed by the school system or district for regular- ly employed teachers.

1	If a substitute teacher becomes a regularly employed
2	teacher in the same district or school system, the
3	salary shall be based on the pay schedule for regu-
4	larly employed teachers, and days worked as a substi-
5	tute shall not be considered in establishing the
6	teacher's salary.
7	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act will be effec-
8	tive on July 1, 1986, and is not retroactive.
9	STATEMENT OF FACT
10	The purpose of this bill is to require that cer-
11	tified substitute teachers be compensated at a rate
12	comparable to that of a beginning teacher.
