	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:								
	14 MRSA §872 is enacted to read:								
	§872. Certain medical malpractice actions; bonds								
	Except as otherwise provided in this section, no person may file any action for medical malpractice unless that person posts a bond in the amount of \$2,000 secured by cash or its equivalent with the clerk of the court in which the action is pending, payable to the defendant for costs assessed, including fees for witnesses, experts and attorneys, if the plaintiff does not prevail in the final judgment.								
	The court may in any medical malpractice action suspend the requirement for posting bond under this

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that any plaintiff in a medical malpractice action post a bond in the amount of \$2,000 to cover legal costs of the defendant if the plaintiff does not prevail. The bill also provides that the bond requirement may be suspended by a court upon a showing of inability to post bond.

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
