20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 26 MRSA §701, as amended by PL 1981, c. 168, §26,  
23 is further amended to read:

24 §701. Posting of notice of hours of labor

25 Every employer shall post and keep posted in a  
26 place accessible for his employees, a printed notice  
27 stating the labor laws regulating the employment of  
28 minors, including the minimum wage paid to student  
29 employees under the age of 19 years pursuant to sec-  
30 tion 654, time of payment of wages, safety and health  
31 of employees and such other laws as may be applica-  
32 ble. The printed form of this notice shall be fur-  
33 nished by the Bureau of Labor Standards.
