Each Representative District shall be 11 formed of contiguous and compact territory and shall 12 cross political subdivision lines the least number of 13 times necessary to establish as nearly as practicable 14 population equally populated districts. Whenever the a municipality entitles it to more than one dis-15 of 16 trict, all whole districts shall be drawn within mu-17 nicipal boundaries. Any population remainder within 18 the municipality shall be included in a district 19 drawn to cross the municipal boundary, provided that 20 such population remainder of the municipality must be 21 contiguous to another municipality or municipalities 22 included in the district.

23 Constitutional referendum procedure; form of 24 question; effective date. Resolved: That the city 25 aldermen, town selectmen and plantation assessors of 26 this State shall notify the inhabitants of their re-27 spective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in 28 the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide 29 election, at a statewide election, on the Tuesday 30 following the first Monday of November following the 31 passage of this resolution, to vote upon the ratifi-32 cation of the amendment proposed in this resolution 33 by voting upon the following question:

34 "Shall the Constitution of Maine be amended as 35 proposed by a resolution of the Legislature to reduce 36 the size of the House of Representatives from 151 to 37 99 members?"

38 The voters of each city, town and legal 39 plantation shall vote by ballot on this question, and shall designate their choice by a cross or check mark 40 41 placed within the corresponding square below the word "Yes" or 42 "No." The ballots shall be received, 43 sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation meetings and returns made to the Secretary 44

of State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor shall review the returns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal votes are in favor of the amendment, the Governor shall proclaim that fact without delay and the amendment shall become part of the Constitution on the date of the proclamation.

8 Secretary of State shall prepare ballots. Re-9 solved: That the Secretary of State shall prepare 10 and furnish to each city, town and plantation all 11 ballots, returns and copies of this resolution neces-12 sary to carry out the purposes of this referendum.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this resolution is to reduce the 15 size of the House of Representatives from 151 to 99.
