22 23 24	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
25 26	Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un- til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and
27 28	Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will become due and payable prior to June 30, 1985; and
29 30 31 32 33 34	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser- vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 2 follows:

3 Sec. 1. Additional allocation of Federal Block 4 Grant Fund. Income to the Federal Block Grant Fund 5 for the fiscal year from July 1, 1984, to June 30, 6 1985, shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed 7 as designated in the following schedule.
