HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 408, L.D. 561, Bill, "AN ACT to Modify and Update Certain Laws Pertaining to Inland Fisheries and Wildlife."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the amendment by renumbering section 3 to be section 2.

Further amend the amendment in section 4, subsection 6, in the 4th, 5th and 6th lines (page 2, lines 34 to 36 in the amendment) by striking out the following: "~~Maine resident person domiciled in Maine, but not resident by reason of being~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'Maine resident' and in the 7th line (page 3, line 1 in the amendment) by inserting after the word "States" the following: 'who is permanently stationed outside of the State'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates the change in the definition of the word "resident." It leaves that term in the section dealing with special license fees for members of the Armed Forces, but adds the provision that they be permanently stationed in the State. It is the intent of this amendment that the definition

2 drivers' licenses, not be strictly enforced as a con-
3 dition of being considered a resident as it pertains
