17 AN ACT Amending the Maine Juvenile Code to
18 Allow the Attorney General to Exercise
19 the Powers of a Juvenile Caseworker in

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 15 MRSA §3203, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

25 1-A. Notification to Attorney General. In cases
26 under Title 5, section 200-A, the law enforcement of-
27 ficer shall immediately notify the Attorney General.
28 The Attorney General or any of his deputies or as-
29 stants shall possess all the powers of a juvenile
30 caseworker specified in this section.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill makes it clear that in cases such as homicides in which an investigation is conducted by the Attorney General or any of his deputies or assistants, they possess all the powers given to the juvenile caseworker in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 15, section 3203.

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
