This bill provides that each person diving, for instance, for scallops shall hold a hand fishing scallop license. It was intended that a crew member, not diving for scallops but physically on board the vessel and doing the shucking of the scallops, do so under the license of an individual who is engaged in diving for scallops from the boat. experience indicates that some divers interpret the law to say that where there is more than one diver on board the boat, they constitute crew and thus may fish under the license of the owner of the boat who holds the hand scallop license. This bill removes the confusing language. Enforcement action is not taken against individuals who are solely involved in the shucking of product on board vessels.
