HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 221, L.D. 584,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Reimburse the Unorganized Territory  
Education and Services Fund for Overcharges from 1978  
to 1983."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after  
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the  
following:

'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1602, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted  
by PL 1983, c. 471, §16, is amended to read:

B. The State Tax Assessor shall establish a  
district-wide mill rate calculated to raise  
the cost of all other portions of the munic-  
ipal cost component certified by the Legis-  
lature. For fiscal years 1985-86, 1986-87,  
1987-88, 1988-89 and 1989-90, in figuring  
the district-wide mill rate, the State Tax  
Assessor shall subtract \$100,000 from the  
amount certified by the Legislature.

Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §1610 is enacted to read:

§1610. Adjustment

In each of the fiscal years 1985-86, 1986-87,  
1987-88, 1988-89 and 1989-90, the amount of \$100,000  
shall be transferred from the General Fund to the Un-  
organized Territory Education and Services Fund.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are  
appropriated from the General Fund for the purposes  
of this Act.
