## 9 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for reimbursement to the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund for withdrawals from that fund that were incorrectly made credits incorrectly withheld during the years 1978 to 1983. The purpose of the Unorganized Terri-Education and Services Fund is to serve as the are colrepository for property tax revenues that lected from taxpayers in the unorganized territory to cover the cost of "municipal" services that are provided in the unorganized territory by the State or the counties. Initially, municipal services provided in the unorganized territory by the State are covered by General Fund appropriations. At the end of each fiscal year, the Bureau of the Budget requests appropriate agencies to list their costs in providing The amount of those costs is then those services. transferred from the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund to the General Fund.

The Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund was established in 1978 as the mechanism for funding of "municipal" services in the unorganized territory. Since that time, some disbursements from the fund have exceeded the amount that should have been withdrawn under the provisions of the law providing for the fund. The following amounts have been incorrectly withdrawn for the following purposes:
