recipients of service and comparisons of the costs and charges of Medicaid services to similar services provided through private insurance and other 3rd party reimbursements. This document shall also list all transfers of funds between Medicaid line accounts or service reimbursements and the reasons for those transfers.

- B. The information provided under paragraph A shall be broken into lines for both federal and state funds, as well as combined totals.
- 2. Submission to Legislature. The budget document prepared pursuant to subsection 1 shall be submitted to the Legislature prior to the beginning of each first regular session. Prior to the beginning of each 2nd regular session, the commissioner shall submit to the Legislature a report summarizing the status of the Medicaid budget, in accordance with the information provided under subsection 1. All budget documents and reports submitted under this section will be transmitted to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs, human resources and other areas, as may be appropriate.
- 3. Public hearing. Following receipt of the Medicaid Budget Report from the commissioner, the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resources shall call a public hearing to receive testimony and comment by recipients, providers and others interested in the Medicaid program. The committee shall consider the content of the report as well as all public testimony in making policy and financial recommendations to the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Each biennium, the Legislature appropriates hundreds of millions of state and federal dollars to the Department of Human Services for the Medicaid program. These funds are not appropriated according to types of services provided, nor is the Legislature given any accounting or detailed information regarding the expenditures of these funds. This bill requires the department to prepare a Medicaid budget document each biennium for the Legislature encompassing a detailed report of Medicaid expenditures, revenues, services and providers. This information will be useful and critical in reviewing the Medicaid budget and addressing important policy decisions presented to the Legislature each year about this program.

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
